



STATE ROUTE 95 PAVEMENT PROJECT

SARA PARK - INTERSTATE 40

Project Cost: \$18.5 million

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation will begin a construction project this summer to replace the riding surface along a 26-mile section of State Route 95. The pavement project is between Sara Park in Mohave County and Lake Havasu City (mileposts 176 to 202).

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Lane restrictions will be limited to overnight hours only and business access will be maintained throughout construction

The restrictions include:

- Overnight intermittent lane restrictions on north- and southbound SR 95 from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday evenings through Friday mornings.
- Drivers should be prepared for delays up to 15 minutes.
- One lane will remain open in each direction.
- The speed limit will be reduced in the work zones.

ADOT reminds drivers to proceed through the work zone with caution, slow down and watch for construction personnel and equipment while the lane restrictions are in place.

Construction is scheduled to begin this summer and be completed in early 2024.

Schedules are subject to change because of weather or other unforeseen factors.

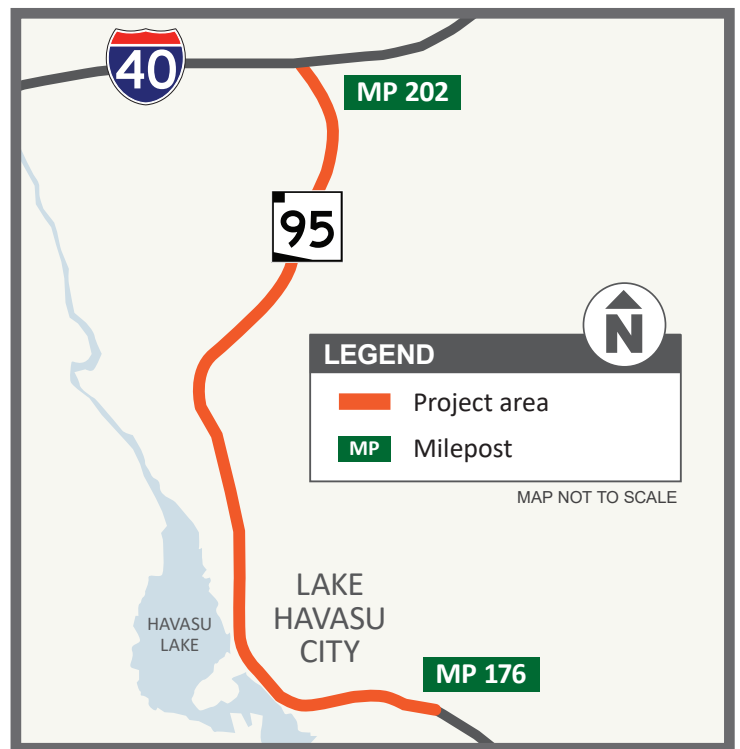
ADOT will post information about the project schedule and traffic restrictions as it becomes available.

PROJECT ELEMENTS

Work includes:

- Removing the top layer of pavement and replacing it with new asphalt.
- Replacing curb and gutter, sidewalk ramps, pavement markings and other related work.
